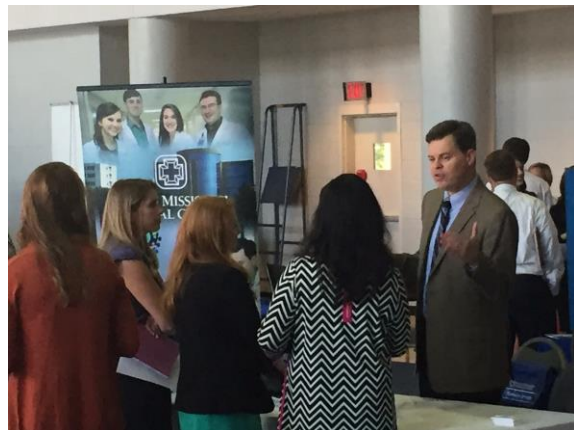
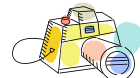
Tripartite Committee Meeting Held
