# **PY4 Spring Seminar Day**

As a part of the Seminar Skills course, PY4 students are required to make a major presentation on the Jackson campus before departmental faculty and other students either in the fall or spring semester. Spring Seminar Day will take place on Tuesday, January 31st for those students that did not present in the fall.

Preceptors may excuse their student for either part or all of the seminar day. Attendance will be closely monitored. The student should be excused long enough to travel to the University of Mississippi Medical Center (UMMC) campus in Jackson.

The student should plan to arrive about 30 minutes before the presentation is scheduled. After the student has given his or her presentation, the student is expected to return to his or her rotation site.

The only exception in which students would not be required to report to rotation before or return to rotation after presenting are those cases in which students are participating in a rotation at a site located more than four hours from the UMMC campus.
