



Community College Counselors/Advisors

This handout is intended to be a general reference and timeline to help community college advisors guide their students interested in a career in pharmacy.

Freshman Year

- Take the required pre-pharmacy courses. This may include remedial courses or pre-requisites required by your school.
- Develop a plan to complete all pre-requisites while completing their AA
- Start gathering information on transfer admissions and scholarships
- Gain leadership, work, and service experience (pharmacy experience, where possible)

Sophomore Year: Fall

- Continue taking pre-requisites
- Apply as a transfer student to the University of Mississippi
 - Complete Scholarship and Special Programs Application
 - Complete housing application, if applicable
- Continue leadership, work, and service activities
- Contact an Admissions Counselor from the School of Pharmacy

Sophomore Year: Spring

- Complete 2nd year pre-requisites and graduate!
- Register for orientation
- Take PCAT in January (optional)

Summer between Sophomore/Junior Year

- Meet with School of Pharmacy Admissions Counselor to check requirements
- Take PCAT (July)
- Start PharmCAS application
